The MAGIC Foundation is an international non-profit organization dedicated to children whose physical growth is affected by a medical problem and adults affected with endocrine disorders. The main objectives of MAGIC are to assist the families of afflicted children and adults and to create public education in the area of children's growth and adult related disorders.

MAGIC was founded in October, 1989, by five families of affected children. They created MAGIC as a way to reach out to others and share not only emotional support but also informational, medical and financial resources. MAGIC assists the parents so they can focus their energy on helping their children. MAGIC expanded years later with support to adults with endocrine disorders

Growth failure is related to a wide variety of syndromes, diseases and disorders of which many are not obvious or well known. It is estimated that more than two million children in the USA are affected by short stature. Many have a problem that may radically affect the quality of their lives. In many cases, medical care can effectively treat the underlying problems. The longer the treatment is delayed the harder it is for a child to catch up.

MAGIC provides a wide variety of informational, educational and support services. The Foundation's mission is to provide a system so complete that no child/adult has to suffer from a preventable or treatable problem. Since its inception in 1989, MAGIC has become the leader in endocrine support for families of children and adults affected with endocrine disorders.


